

Oregon's Process for Electing Delegates to the 2020 Democratic National Convention



1st Determining Stage: State Run Primary-May 19th

- Anyone registered as a Democrat by April 28th can participate
- Vote By Mail
- Delegates apportioned off primary results on May 22nd, 2020

May 21st - Deadline to Sign Up to Participate in the Delegate Selection Process

- Sign up at DPO.org/2020 by 5 p.m. Pacific Time
- Declare Presidential Preference
- Sign Up to Be A Voter
- Sign Up to Run as a Delegate and/or Alternate to the Democratic National Convention

2nd Stage: Vote By Mail Delegate Elections, ballots mailed on May 27th, 2020

Any registered Democrat who signs up by the May 21st deadline will receive a Ballot Packet in the mail with up to 3 Ballots (depending on how delegates are allocated to your preferred Presidential Candidate):

- Ballot for District Level Delegates for the Voter's Congressional District
- Ballot for Party Leader Elected Official Delegates
- Ballot for At-Large Delegates/Alternates

Every Voter will also get access to an online version of their ballots

3rd Stage: Ballots Due June 12th

Ballots must be received by the DPO no later than 5 p.m. Pacific Time on June 12th. This is the deadline for both mail-in and online ballots. Postmarks will not be honored.

- Ballots will be tabulated in the following order. Once a Delegate is elected, that candidate is removed from consideration in further rounds.
 1. District Level Delegates
 2. PLEO Delegates
 3. At Large Delegates (At Large Alternates are Selected from the runners-up on this ballot)
- Once ballots are tabulated and results verified, results will be reported out.
